The position

- Coordination with authorities and ensure that permits are followed
- Verify and approve the requested payments according to progress and quality
- Coordination and reporting across the project matrix organisation

You have a degree in civil engineering or similar and at least 5-10 years' experience from on-site construction management of complex projects.

The ideal candidate will have the following attributes:

- Strong engineering skills within large civil works' structures
