- Assuring that the project can be approved according to railway safety- and interoperability regulations.
- Participating in the tender process for construction contracts.
- Following up on works performed by external contractors.
- Participating in commissioning and hand over from project to operating organization.

- Are experienced in railway projects it will be an advantage if you have knowledge in tracksystems including IT-Software used for Track-Design.
- Have knowledge about Danish and European norms and standards.
